

Cornish Lithium Hard Rock Summer Newsletter 2023



Recent work at site

A planning application has been submitted to Cornwall Council for the proposed construction and use of a new vehicular access from Trelavour Downs onto Brewers Hill. The proposed access has been designed to enable operational needs such as mobilisation of exploratory drilling and ancillary equipment, maintenance vehicle access and Emergency services access. The application details will be out for public consultation shortly.

Work to create a new permissive path along the northern boundary of the site is progressing, vegetation clearance along the new route is being supervised by our ecologists and surfacing is expected to begin soon.

Long lead items for the Demonstration Plant at TreLith have been ordered, some initial components have begun to arrive on site with construction due to commence later in the year. The facility, including a new laboratory and visitor centre, will be commissioned during 2024.

A presentation evening for the community will be held in the early Autumn to provide an update on the Trelavour project. The details of this will be shared online nearer to the time. This will be a chance for the local community to find out more information and ask any questions they may have.

2023 Cornish Lithium Community Fund

In 2022 Cornish Lithium partnered with Cornwall Community Foundation (CCF) to announce a £20,000 fund eligible for groups local to Cornish Lithium project areas. Following its success, the 2023 fund is now open for applications, and can be found on the CCF website. Communities around the china clay area nearby to the hard rock project are eligible to apply for a share of this fund, with grants awarded between £250 and £2,500. Communities around the lithium in geothermal waters projects are also eligible to apply, including areas such as Gwennap, Carharrack and St Day, Lanner, Chacewater and Blackwater. Applications are open until the 18th September and can be made via the CCF website:

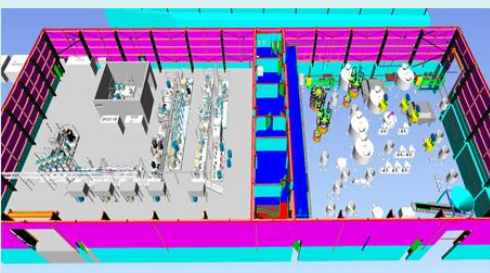

As you may have seen in the press, Cornish Lithium have raised £53.6 million from The UK Infrastructure Bank, who are owned and financed by the UK Government, and a consortium of specialist mining investors.
